Extra-biblical sources confirm Christ's death



Josephus: "Pilate, at the suggestion of the principal men among us, had condemned him to the cross."

Talmud: "on the eve of Passover they hanged Yeshu of Nazareth."

Phlegon: "Jesus, while alive, was of no assistance to himself, but that he arose after death, and exhibited the marks of his punishment, and showed how his hands had been pierced by nails."




- Marcus Borg: execution by Romans "the most certain fact about the historical Jesus"





importance of the word "Christian"


 Tacitus - Annals: history of the Roman Empire from Tiberius to Nero (14-68AD)

 Explaining the fire in Rome: "to get rid of the report, Nero fastened the guilt and inflicted the most exquisite tortures of a class hated for their abominations, *called Christians by the populace.*"





"God raised Jesus from the dead"

- I. simple, unvarnished message from Day One:
 - Acts 2:32 this Jesus God raised up
 - Acts 3:15 you killed the Author of life, whom
 God raised from the dead
 - Acts 4:10 Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead
 - Acts 5:30 the God of our fathers raised Jesus

"God raised Jesus from the dead"

- Acts 10:40 God raised him up on the third day
- Acts 13:30 God raised him from the dead
- Acts 17:31 he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.
- Acts 26:8 Why is it thought incredible by any of you that God raises the dead?

Early Christian Creed

- Jesus died 30/33AD; Paul writes in 55AD
- For I delivered to you (52AD) as of first importance what I also received (35AD? - Galatians 1):
 - That Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared...(Cephas, 12, 500, James, all, Paul)

"God raised Jesus from the dead"

- first-century men were not gullible
 - they "knew" dead people stay dead
 - disbelieved testimony of women (Mk 16:11;
 Lk 24:11)
 - disbelieved testimony of men (Mk 16:12-13)
 - disbelieved own eyes (Matt. 28:17)

Four Indisputable Facts of History

Jesus died by crucifixion

 Jesus' disciples sincerely believed Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to them

"It may be taken as historically certain that Peter and the disciples had experiences after Jesus' death in which Jesus appeared to them as the risen Christ." Gerd Ludemann (atheist NT scholar)
